



Competition Supplementary Rules for Level 2 Covid-19 Requirements

The following changes to our club competitions are required to meet the requirements of level 2 Covid-19 (100 people max)

1. Physical distancing of **2 metres** must be kept at all times
2. Registration will be held at the clubrooms with **only the skippers of each boat attending** – no additional crew or family members are permitted. Entries to competition will close at 6:00pm on the day of registration. **No late entries will be accepted.**
3. **Briefing will be held at 7 pm..**
4. Spot prizes by lucky draw, all entrants are eligible and the skipper is to uplift their prize directly from the table for the entrant from their boat (angler doesn't need to be there to qualify but the angler's skipper does)
5. Payment for non-early bird anglers can be completed at the bar by EFTPOS or credit card, they must have completed the registration and disclaimer form.
6. The rules will be posted on the clubs website
7. **Competition Day**
 - Only authorised people to enter the upstairs office – no entries on the day
 - Radio Operator gives the go ahead for the competition and checks boat registration & POB.
 - Skippers to log in and out with Radio Operator.
 - Weigh station - each boat will wait in line (max 2 people per boat) at the weigh station to have their fish weighed (2 metre physical distance) – follow markings and signs
 - The skipper of each boat will be placing their team's fish on the scales for the weighmaster to verify, skippers to ensure correct details of each entrant match the fish being weighed.
 - Weighmaster and Weigh Station recorder to keep a minimum distance of 2 metres from scales. The weighmaster will not handle fish.
 - Once the skipper has completed the weighing of their fish, they must clean the area prior to leaving.
 - **Note: there will be no prize giving ceremony for this competition**
8. The results of the prize giving will be published on the club's Website with a link to the Facebook page, Fishy Tales and within the clubrooms



9. All prizes will be labelled with the person's name and stored in the Club Captains store room.
10. Prizes to be collected from the clubrooms the following week of the competition Tuesday and Thursday 5pm-6pm. A Fishing Committee member will be present for prize collection. People collecting prizes must have their club card for proof of identity. Prizes will not be held after 31 May 2020 unless by prior arrangement.
11. Other than the Skipper, under no circumstance will anyone be able to collect prizes for other entrants.
12. People collecting prizes will sign off that they have collected their prize.
